Terms and Conditions
Memorial Plaques
The Columbarium at St. Dominic's Catholic Church
Remembering Our Loved Ones

St. Dominic's Catholic Church in San Francisco ("St. Dominic's") in conjunction with the St. Dominic's Columbarium Advisory Board (the "Board") has developed terms and conditions with respect to participation in The Columbarium at St. Dominic's ("The Columbarium"). These terms and conditions are intended to provide for proper and efficient operation of the Columbarium for the benefit of persons memorialized or inurned at The Columbarium, their family and friends, St. Dominic's and St. Dominic's parishioners.

These terms and conditions are an integral part of your Pricing and Payment Cenotaph Memorial Agreement with St. Dominic's regarding The Columbarium. The Board may also establish rules and regulations from time to time for the administration of The Columbarium.

The following are terms and conditions of the agreement between the subscriber(s), whose name(s) appears at the end of this Exhibit A, and St. Dominic's pertaining to The Columbarium at St. Dominic's Catholic Church in San Francisco, California.

1. Subscriber does not acquire any title or other property rights, or the right of ownership or tenancy, in any property at St. Dominic's or the St. Dominic's Columbarium. The reservation after payment in full, the wall of remembrance confers only the right to memorialize the designated person(s) on the identified bench or memorial plaque displayed at The Columbarium pursuant to St. Dominic's terms, conditions, rules and regulations, as amended from time to time. The Columbarium and the space, and benches, and cenotaph memorials, their use and maintenance, are at all times the property and subject to management and control by St. Dominic's.

2. Memorialization at The Columbarium on The Wall of Remembrance is available to the registered parishioners, associate members, non-parishioners and to all those who have an affiliation with or affection for St. Dominic's. The name(s) of the person(s) to be memorialized is specified in writing at the end of this Exhibit A. The sequence of names on the wall of remembrance shall be as determined by St. Dominic's in its sole and absolute discretion. No substitution of the person or persons designated below may be made unless approved in advance by St. Dominic's, which St. Dominic's may grant or deny, condition or delay, in its sole and absolute discretion, and annexed in writing hereto.

3. The size, shape, type, font, material and placement of each and every memorial plaque or bench shall be as specified by St. Dominic's from time to time. Memorial inscriptions on The Wall of Remembrance are limited to name, date of birth and date of death for each person memorialized. St. Dominic's will provide engraving for the memorial plaques to ensure consistency.

4. The number of characters allowed for a name on a memorial plaque is limited to a maximum of 28 (twenty eight) characters INCLUDING spaces, dashes, hyphens, commas, letters or any type of character with the possible exception of tildes.

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5. St. Dominic's will endeavor to exercise thorough and reasonable care in maintaining, improving and when necessary or appropriate in the judgment of St. Dominic's (in its sole and absolute discretion), including but not limited to, increasing the size of The Columbarium. However, St. Dominic's assumes no liability for destruction or damage to The Columbarium, the ashes inurned therein, or the urns or memorial benches or memorial plaques for any reason.
6. No visitations to The Columbarium are permitted during Masses, weddings, funerals or other religious services. This includes visits to the niches, Wall of Remembrance with memorials, or the memorial benches.
7. St. Dominic's may temporarily remove the cenotaph(s), plaques, or benches while making repairs, engraving, for improvements or due to a natural disaster to The Columbarium.
8. The Wall of Remembrance memorial plaques shall be placed as determined by St. Dominic's. The Wall of Remembrance will have 6 plaque names per faceplate.
9. Memorial plaques are to be paid in full at the time of purchase. Plaques will be sold only in numerical sequence. There is only one name per plaque inscription plus the date of birth and date of death. There are 2 lines of engraving for each person. The name on line 1. The date of birth and date of death on line 2.
10. Plaques will not be engraved or installed until all 6 plaque names on a faceplate have been purchased and paid in full.
11. Memorialization on plaques will continue as long as they are available and as long as the present Columbarium stands and is owned by St. Dominic's.
12. Memorial plaques are limited to the memory of the deceased.
13. St. Dominic's reserves the right to provide memorials at reduced costs or fees to persons that cannot otherwise afford it or under special circumstances determined by St. Dominic's.
14. Subscriber acknowledges and accepts the following facts about the faceplate and bench materials. Stone may vary in color and appearance. Natural occurring imperfections may be present.
15. Subscriber binds his/her estate, devisees and assigns to fulfilling the obligations and exercising the privileges herein.
